

Music note for the 8am Easter Sunday service

Felix Mendelssohn was commissioned in 1844 to write a 'set of voluntaries' by the English publishers Coventry and Hollier. Mendelssohn wrote six sonatas for that commission; the prelude for the 8:00 service on Easter Sunday was the first movement of the third sonata in the series. In the beginning of the third sonata, Mendelssohn uses music that he originally wrote for his sister Fanny's wedding. The movement's second section is in A minor; listen to the pedals to hear the chorale tune *Aus tiefer Not*. "Aus tiefer Not schrei ich zu dir" can be translated as "From the deep I cry out to thee." The tune can be found at number 151 in *The Hymnal 1982*. The third section continues in minor with the *Aus tiefer Not* chorale continuing in the pedals, with the chorale tune transforming into a triumphant pedal line. This exuberant pedal line takes us back to A major, with music that is similar to the music from the beginning of the piece. -Sean Fleming
