Brent Douglass to play this Sunday

This Sunday we welcome Brent Douglass as our guest organist for the next three Sundays. Below is his music note for this Sunday

Music note for Sunday, August 21

The organ voluntaries this Sunday are all settings of the traditional hymn tunes in the processional hymn, offertory hymn, and recessional hymn.

Ein feste Burg ist unser Gott (A mighty fortress is our God) was written by 16th century German priest and hymnwriter Martin Luther. In addition to being a prolific hymnwriter, Luther is well known for his translation of the Bible from Latin to German, which dramatically increased the accessibility of the Scripture for the common people. Bach used this very familiar chorale tune in his Cantata 80.

Schmucke dich, O liebe Seele (Deck thyself, my soul, with gladness), a German chorale tune, was written in the 17th century by Johann Crüger, a Lutheran cantor. Bach used this tune in his Cantata 180. Many organ preludes have been written based on this beautiful melody.

CWM Rhondda, a universally known Welsh hymn tune, was composed in 1905 by John Hughes. It is most notably set to the text "Guide me O thou great Jehovah" and "God of Grace and God of Glory." -Brent Douglass

Mask Update

The vestry met on Tuesday, July 19. This is the Vestry Approved COVID-19 Policy as of their meeting. At each monthly meeting of the vestry, the members thoughtfully consider the best practices for St. Andrew's in regards to Masking. The following was approved at this month's vestry meeting, effective immediately: Following the CDC risk categories of green (low transmission)/yellow (moderate transmission)/ red (high transmission)

When Lincoln County is in the green category. Masking in St. Andrew's building is optional for both worship and meetings. We *will sing* during worship.

When Lincoln County is in the yellow category. Masking in St. Andrew's building is optional for both worship and meetings. We *will not sing* during worship.

When Lincoln County is in the red category. Masking in St. Andrew's building is mandatory for both worship and meetings. We *will not sing* during worship.

We will check the status of Lincoln County on Friday mornings.
