## **Mask Update**

The vestry met on Tuesday, July 19. This is the Vestry Approved COVID-19 Policy as of their meeting. At each monthly meeting of the vestry, the members thoughtfully consider the best practices for St. Andrew's in regards to Masking. The following was approved at this month's vestry meeting, effective immediately: Following the CDC risk categories of green (low transmission)/yellow (moderate transmission)/ red (high transmission)

When Lincoln County is in the green category: Masking in St. Andrew's building is optional for both worship and meetings. We *will sing* during worship.

When Lincoln County is in the yellow category: Masking in St. Andrew's building is optional for both worship and meetings. We *will not sing* during worship.

When Lincoln County is in the red category: Masking in St. Andrew's building is mandatory for both worship and meetings. We *will not sing* during worship.

We will check the status of Lincoln County on Friday mornings.
