Damariscotta organist Sean Fleming will present an organ recital at the First Congregational Church of Searsport, 8 Church St., on Sunday, October 8 at 3:00 p.m. Featured on the 1906 E.W. Lane pipe organ will be Bach's Sinfonia from Cantata 29, the Guilfant Organ Sonata No.1 in D minor, "Concert Variations on the Austrian Hymn" by the Maine-born composer John Knowles Paine, a beautiful setting of "Rhosymedre" by Ralph Vaughan Williams, and the famous Widor Toccata.
