ANNUAL MEETING

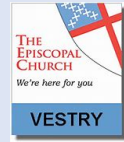
St. Andrew's Annual Parish Meeting

First Sunday Plate Outreach Recipient for March: CHIP, Inc.

The First Sunday plate cash collected from this Sunday's service will be sent to support CHIP (Community Housing Improvement Project). As well as donating plate cash, you may also make checks payable to "CHIP" and place them in the plate or mail them to St. Andrews.

Since 1984, CHIP, Inc. has been fulfilling a mission of neighbors helping neighbors keep their homes safe, warm and dry by providing services such as weatherproofing, replacement of windows and doors, handicap access ramps and electrical and plumbing repairs for Lincoln County homeowners who are not able to do so themselves because of illness, disability or financial need. These repairs are undertaken by volunteers and professionals at no cost to the homeowner. During the winter months, CHIP also provides limited emergency deliveries of heating oil and firewood to those in need.

Music Note for this Sunday, March 3

The prelude and communion voluntary for March 3 are both based on the tune Adoro devote. The tune is used for hymn 314 "Humbly I adore thee," that we'll sing on Sunday.

The earliest-known source for this melody is a Parisian processional manuscript, dating from 1697, where it is set to a hymn (text) for the Feast of Corpus Christi, "Adoro te supplex," by Thomas Aquinas. - Sean Fleming
