What is CLYNK? It is an easy way to turn in your redeemable bottles and drink cans and benefit St. Andrew's at the same time. Pick up a green CLYNK bag from the basket in the Atrium. Take it home and fill it (not too heavy please) with your redeemable bottles and cans. When it's about half full, take it to Hannaford's Redemption room, just to the left as you enter the store. Use the bar code scanner to scan the sticker on your bag. This will send the credit to St. Andrew's CLYNK account.
