## Nihkaniyane: Let's Go Forward Together

The Wabanaki Alliance will host its second annual celebration of friendships and alliances, 5:30-7 PM on Thursday, July 11, in the backyard of the Abbe Museum in Bar Harbor. The event is called Nihkaniyane: Let's Go Forward Together. The Wabanaki Alliance was formed in 2020 when the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians, Mi'kmaq Nation, Passamaquoddy Tribe, and Penobscot Nation joined together to work to improve upon the 1980 Maine Indian Claims Settlement Act (MISCA) and educate the public on tribal histories and communities. The Episcopal Diocese of Maine is one of over 280 organizations in Maine

that have joined the Wabanaki Alliance Tribal Coalition. # **Haiti Fund Message**

For the next month, our Lincoln County group is trying to raise money to feed the children in the Gros Morne schools including the two Episcopal schools. Although the gangs in the capital have closed and ransacked many schools in the capital to the south, Gros Morne's schools have been kept running. Food, however, is short. Gang blockades of the main roads have made food transportation difficult and traditional suppliers like the World Food Program have suspended support. If you will make out a check to St. Andrew's Church with Haiti Fund on the memo line, we will send the funds to our friends in Gros Morne for distribution.
