Please consider joining us on October 19 from 9am -1pm to help pull weeds, prune, haul debris, etc. on our beautiful and growing church grounds. It should



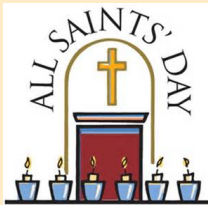
be a good and rewarding time. There will be coffee and may be donuts. If you are interested, please bring your favorite gardening tools, a rake and a tarp if you have one.

First Sunday Outreach Recipient for October: Trinity Jubilee Center

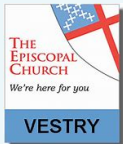
Thanks to your donations last Sunday, we were able to donate \$376 to help support the many missions of the Trinity Jubilee Center.
