Note about the music for December 15 at 10am

Craig Sellar Lang (1891-1972) was born in New Zealand but spent most of his life in England. He studied in England at Clifton College and the Royal College of Music. At the RCM he studied with Stanford. He

was for sixteen years Director of Music at Christ's Hospital School in Horsham, West Sussex. Lang's *Voluntary on Winchester New* has the melody (which is set to #76 "On Jordan's Bank" in The Hymnal 1982) played by the left hand with a harmony part played in the pedals. Meanwhile the right hand plays a fast and florid accompaniment. -Sean Fleming

Sing with Senior Choir Christmas Eve!


