### Music note for this Sunday, December 28

Please welcome John David Adams and Rick Humphrey to the 10:00 service this Sunday. They will be singing a piece by Johann Sebastian Bach; the duet Jesus soll mein alles sein from Cantata 190: Singet dem Herrn ein neues Lied (Sing unto the Lord a new song). This cantata was based on verses from Psalms 149 and 150, and was first performed in Leipzig on January 1, 1724.

The poem "Love came down at Christmas" was originally published by the English poet Christina Rossetti (1830-1894) in *Time Flies: a Reading Diary* (1885). The tune in The Hymnal 1982 is an old Irish tune first printed in *The Complete Collection of Irish Music as Noted by George Petrie* (1902-1905).

Another poem by Christina Rossetti, "In the bleak midwinter," was published, under the title "A Christmas Carol," in the January 1872 issue of *Scribner's Monthly*, and was first collected in book form in *Goblin Market, The Prince's Progress and Other Poems* (1875).
