There Is More to the Apple than Meets the Eye!

Join us at Coffee Hour after each service on Sunday, January 25, for an entertaining and informative talk all about the apple. This iconic fruit touches almost every aspect of our culture. Presenter Ron Ross, and



his partner Fred Kraeuter, started with 6 apple trees when they moved to Boothbay in 2012 and now have 75 trees representing 50 heirloom variety apples. They also coordinate a volunteer group, The Apple Corps, which manages two orchards for the Boothbay Region Land Trust.

Brett Donham will be offering a slide lecture series on the Italian Renaissance painter, **Piero Della Francesca**, to be held in the undercroft of St. Andrews Church on 3, 10, & 17 February at 1:00 PM. Titled; **Piero Della Francesca: Painter, Mathematician, Philosopher, a True Renaissance Man** the lectures will focus on his religious paintings, including **Resurrection**, described by Aldous Huxley as "the best picture in the world".
