#### St. Andrew's Church services for October, 2021

#### Sunday, 8:00am - In-person, indoor service of Holy Eucharist, Rite I

No sign up is required. There will be no congregational singing. You will be asked to sign in. Masks are once again required at the indoor service regardless of vaccination status.

#### Sunday, 10:00am - In-person, outdoor service of Holy Eucharist, Rite II

No sign up is required and please bring chairs as you are able. There will be congregational singing at the outside service. Masks are no longer required but you may do so if you are more comfortable.. There will be no tent so please check your email for cancellation notification if the weather is bad or call the church (563-3533) and listen for an updated message. If the outdoor service is cancelled, you may watch the livestreamed indoor service on facebook or later on youtube.

## St. Andrew's Church services for November, 2021

# Sundays at 8:00am: Zoom Morning Prayer service (not inside the building)

This service will not be livestreamed or recorded, but the link will be made available to all members through our weekly newsletter. This service will be a simplified version of what we did earlier in the Pandemic. There will be time to remain after the service is finished to have a virtual coffee hour. Anyone is welcome to join this virtual coffee hour at about 8:45, even if not attending the morning prayer service.

#### Sundays at 10:00am: Celebration of Holy Eucharist in person in the church

On the first Sunday of the month we will use Rite I and on the other Sundays Rite II. We will be masked

with no singing. This service will be livestreamed on Facebook and will be available later in the day on YouTube. We will hear recordings of the choir singing. There will be no coffee or food served following the service, as this would require the removal of masks, but anyone is welcome to gather for a time of fellowship in either the Atrium or the Undercroft.
